## HOUSE RULES

Dear visitors,

We would like to welcome you most cordially to the Fridericianum at the documenta und Museum Fridericianum gGmbH and wish you a pleasant stay. Our House Rules apply to everybody. They cover the building's indoor and outdoor areas including the Café at the Fridericianum. The precept of mutual respect and consideration applies. Please follow the staff's instructions at all times.

### 1. BAGS AND OTHER ITEMS

You may not take bags and backpacks into the exhibition halls. You may keep a handbag or shoulderbag with you as long as it does not exceed the size of 23 x 33 x 10 cm (w/h/d). This rule may be suspended on occasion; please heed any instructions in the halls in this regard. Other bulky items that exceed the above size are not permitted in the halls. Exceptions are walking aids or children's buggies. Please refrain from carrying larger items of clothing over your arm.

You are not allowed to take dangerous items with you (e.g., pyrotechnical items, gas containers), disruptive appliances (e.g. laser pointers) or process materials (e.g. glues/adhesives).

Please do not take wet clothing with you into the exhibition halls as it can potentially cause damage to sensitive exhibits.

Please make use of the lockers in the basement to safely store items that are not permitted in the exhibition halls. We cannot assume any liability for items stored in the lockers or elsewhere.

### 2. ARTWORKS

Please do not touch the artworks, display cases or plinths. Please maintain a distance of at least 80 cm from the exhibits. Exceptions are artworks where touching is explicitly intended.

### 3. SITE-SPECIFIC CAUTION

Please be very careful when spending time in the outdoor areas and/or entering artworks that you can walk into/through. Please make sure you are wearing appropriate shoes.

### 4. FOOD AND BEVERAGES

Eating and drinking are not permitted in the exhibition halls. Food and beverages can be purchased in the Café at the Fridericianum. We ask for your understanding that you may not consume food or beverages you have brought with you in the café.



## 5. SMOKING AND INTOXICANTS

Smoking, including e-cigarettes/vaping, is forbidden throughout the museum building. We reserve the right to deny access to the building to persons who are discernibly under the influence of alcohol or drugs. The consumption of cannabis is not permitted in the area of the Porticus.

## 6. CHILDREN

We are always excited to welcome our youngest visitors and would ask the accompanying adults to please make sure the safety of the artworks is not at risk and other visitors are not disturbed. Children are not allowed to run or scamper about. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by at least one responsible adult; this applies to school classes, too. Children's buggies are permitted in the exhibition halls under the assumption of the visitors' mutual consideration. You may, if you so wish, place your buggy in the Studiowerkstatt while visiting the exhibition.

## 7. ANIMALS

You may not take animals into the exhibition halls. Assistance dogs are excluded from this. Dogs must be kept on a leash in the outdoor areas.

## 8. EXHIBITION TOURS

Commercial services such as those provided by tour guides or art educators may only be offered within the museum by persons authorized by the documenta und Museum Fridericianum gGmbH. For further details, please contact [education@fridericianum.org](mailto:education@fridericianum.org).

## 9. PHOTOGRAPHING AND FILMING

Photographing, filming or making any other form of recording is only permissible for private purposes; without the use of camera flash, tripods or selfie sticks. Individual works that may not be photographed will be marked accordingly. You will need to obtain written permission for recordings for all purposes that go beyond the above. ## 10. NOISE

In order to ensure a pleasant stay for all visitors, we would ask you to avoid making noise as far as possible, to mute your mobile phones and be considerate of the other visitors.
